



## **PETERBOROUGH LAKEFIELD POLICE SERVICES BOARD**

### **LE-002 - Communications and Dispatch**

1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board with respect to communications and dispatch services that:
  - a) the police service will provide the services of communications by using the police service's own members; and
  - b) the Chief of Police will:
    - i) ensure that 24 hours a day a member of the police service is available to supervise police communications and dispatch services;
    - ii) ensure that police officers on patrol have a portable two-way voice communication capability that allows the police officers to be in contact with the communications centre when away from their vehicle or on foot patrol;
    - iii) establish procedures and processes on communications and dispatch services; and
    - iv) ensure that members who provide communications and dispatch services meet the requirements of the Adequacy Standards Regulation.

2. **Administration**

- 2.1 That Policy 2004-04 Communications and Dispatch passed the 9<sup>th</sup> day of March 2004 be repealed.
- 2.2 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board on this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March 2006 and shall take effect on that date.
