LE-004 - Criminal Intelligence

1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board with respect to criminal intelligence that:
 - a) criminal intelligence will be provided by using the police services' own members;
 - b) the Chief of Police will:
 - i) establish priorities and procedures for criminal intelligence, including strategic and tactical intelligence;
 - ii) promote the use of criminal intelligence analysis by supervisors to identify areas or issues requiring directed patrol, targeted enforcement or problem-oriented policing initiatives; and
 - iii) ensure, if the police service uses its own members to perform the criminal intelligence function, that the members have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform this function and the necessary tools and equipment.

2. Administration

- 2.1 That Policy 2001-06 Criminal Intelligence passed the 11th day of December 2001, be repealed.
- 2.2 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board on this 9th day of March, 2004 and shall take effect on that date.
