LE-014 - Court Security

1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board with respect to court security that the Chief of Police will:
 - a) establish a local court security committee, to serve in an advisory capacity to the Chief of Police, comprised of representatives, at minimum, from the police, Crown, judiciary, local bar, victim services/organizations and Court Services - Ministry of the Attorney General;
 - b) prepare a court security plan, in consultation with the local court security committee, that adequately addresses local needs and circumstances, and meets the statutory responsibilities set out in section 137 of the *Police Services Act*; and
 - c) ensure that police officers and special constables utilized for court security are supervised and have the knowledge, skills and abilities to perform the function.

2. Administration

- 2.1 That Policy 2004- 16 Court Security passed the 9th day of March 2004, be repealed.

2.2 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board on this 16th day of March 2006 and shall take effect on that date.
