LE-028 - Criminal Harassment

1. It is the policy of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board with respect to undertaking and managing investigations into criminal harassment that the Chief of Police will develop and maintain procedures that address:
 - a) the procedures for investigating criminal harassment complaints in accordance with the police service's criminal investigation management plan;
 - b) the use of enhanced investigative techniques, such as behavioural science services as part of the investigation;
 - c) the provision of victims' assistance;
 - d) the information to be provided to police officers on criminal harassment; and
 - e) compliance with the Ministry's designated *Ontario Major Case Management Manual* for criminal harassment cases that fall within the definition of major case.

2. Administration

- 2.1 That Policy 2004- 30 Criminal Harassment passed the 9th day of March 2004, be repealed.
- 2.2 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board on this 16th day of March 2006 and shall take effect on that date.
