LE-047 – Police Response to High Risk Individuals

It is the policy of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board with respect to Police Response to High Risk Individuals:

1. The Chief of Police will:
 - a) Work in partnership, where possible, with the local Crown, appropriate community members and agencies, including health care providers, government agencies, municipal officials, other criminal justice agencies, including law enforcement agencies, as well as victim services to ensure a coordinated and effective strategy in response to high risk individuals that addresses: bail opposition consistent with the Ministry's guideline on Bail and Violent Crime;
 - i) dangerous offender and long term offender applications;
 - ii) High Risk Offender Nationals Flagging System and requirements of CPIC;
 - iii) information sharing;
 - iv) case management planning;
 - v) judicial restraint orders;
 - vi) victim assistance; and
 - vii) disclosure of information, including community notification and safety planning;
 - b) and ensure that the police service's skills development and learning plan addresses the training and sharing of information with officers, communication operators/dispatchers and supervisors on the police response to high risk individuals.

2. Administration

- 2.1 That is policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board on this 14th day of February 2006, and shall take effect on that date.
