



## **Court Security - Special Constable Positions**

This position offers the successful candidate the opportunity for a rewarding career as a Special Constable with the Peterborough Lakefield Community Police Service. Duties include prisoner transportation, court security, searching, guarding and controlling prisoners.

### **Qualifications**

All applicants for the position of Court Security - Special Constable with Peterborough Lakefield Community Police Service must meet the following criteria to be considered in the selection process:

- Candidates must have Secondary School Graduation Diploma or equivalent by the Ministry of Education. Preference will be given to candidates that have demonstrated continuous learning beyond high school and have proven involvement within the community
- Must possess a valid Standard First Aid and CPR level "C" certificate
- Valid class "G" drivers licence with a clear driving record
- Clear criminal record
- Candidates must be able to read, comprehend written data, memos, notes, and verbal instructions, and relay information clearly to others
- Must relate well to others with courtesy, tact and professionalism and excellent communication/teamwork skills
- Candidates must be able to work under highly stressful situations and respond and deal with urgent situations and make quick decisions

**Candidates must provide a copy of (OACP) Certificate of Test Results for Special Constables with application.**

#### **Where is the testing done?**
