East City is in Area 4.



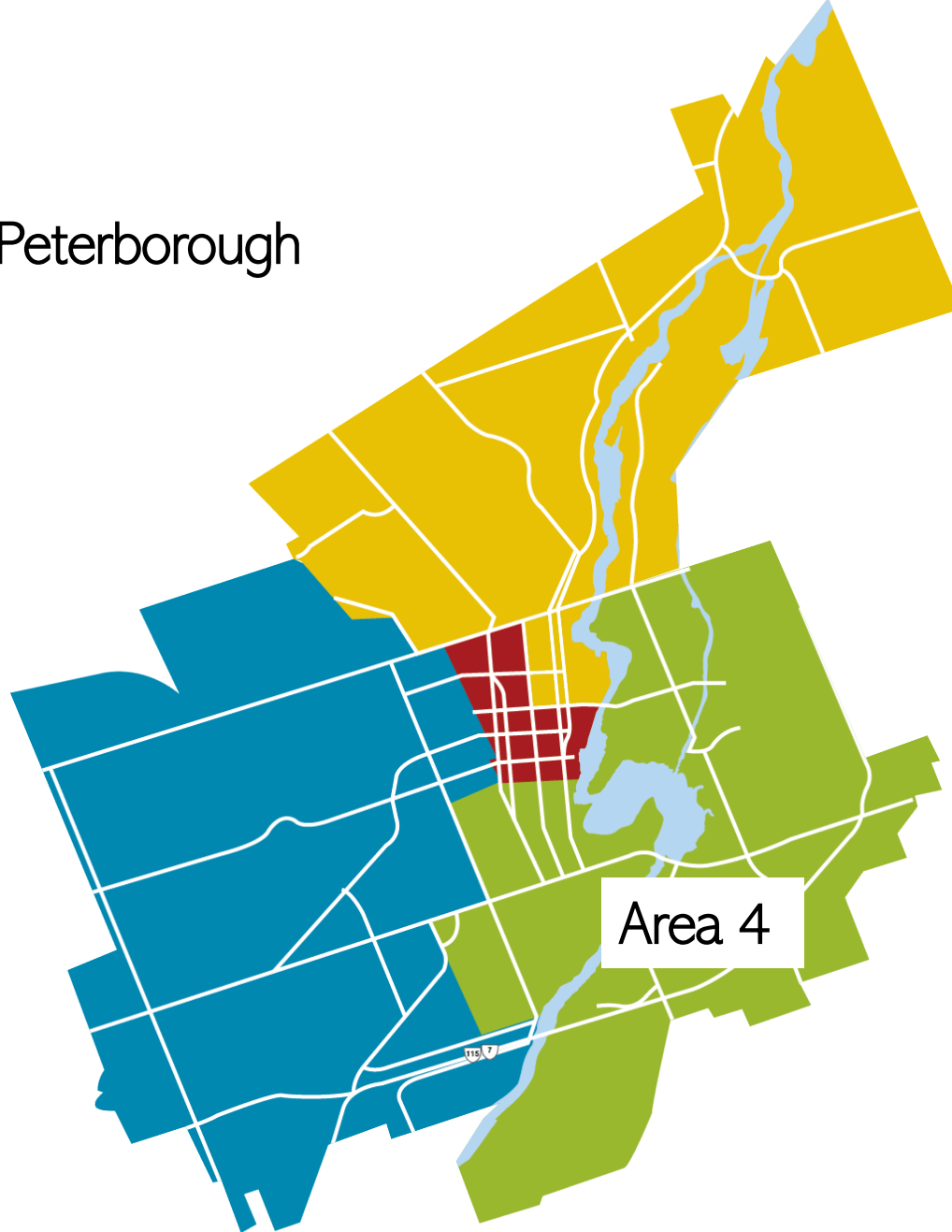

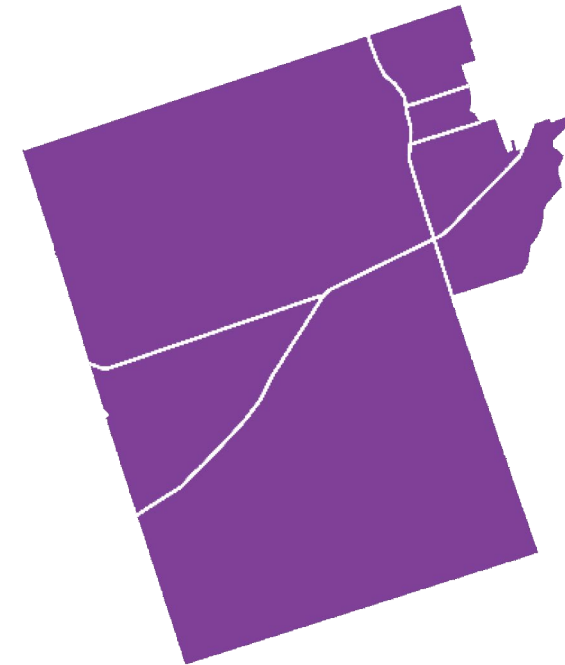

Crime Severity Index (CSI)

Overall CSI (Violent & Non-Violent)

Peterborough is **21st** out of the 43 municipal police services. Overall CSI  **5.07%** over 2022.

Violent CSI

Peterborough is **15th** out of the 43 municipal police services. Violent CSI has  **1%** over 2022.

Non-Violent CSI

Peterborough is **23rd** out of the 43 municipal police services. Non-Violent CSI has  **7.37%** over 2022.

Statistics



Peterborough Police Service (All Areas)

26,699 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Aug 31/24) ↑ 10%

4415 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 16.5%

3079 criminal charges have been laid = ↑ 33%

Largest increase in charges were for: Theft Under \$5,000 (↑ 61%)

Fail to Comply with Probation (↑ 53%) & Possession of Property Obtained by Crime (↑ 39%)

Area 4 – South/East

6045 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Aug 31/24)  12%

1197 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 19.8%

Area 4 covers most of the south-east of the City of Peterborough, including Lansdowne Place.

It is a mix of business, residential and institutional.

When to call 9-1-1

- Call 9-1-1 if it is an emergency and you require police, fire or ambulance for a crime in progress
- Your life or someone else's is in danger (eg assault, motor vehicle collision, impaired driver, active fire)
- You or someone else is having a medical episode

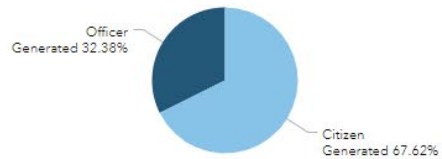

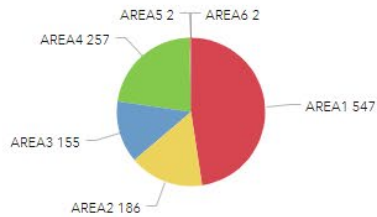

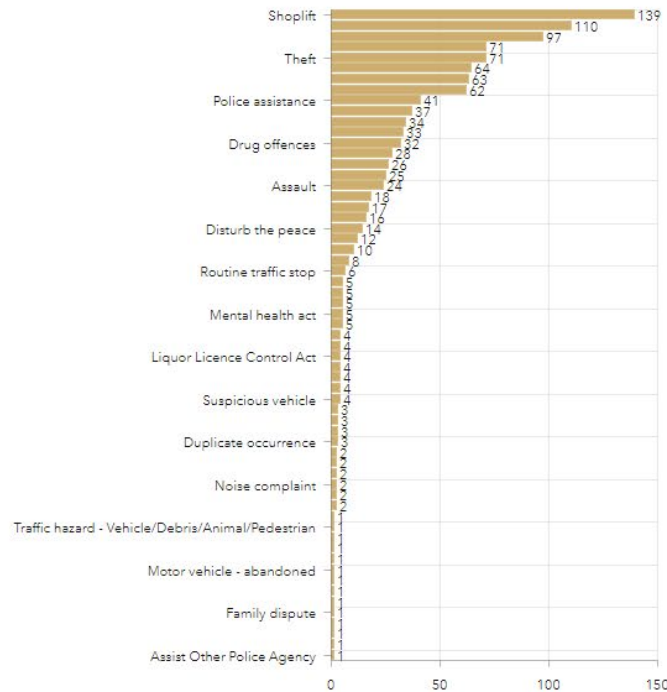

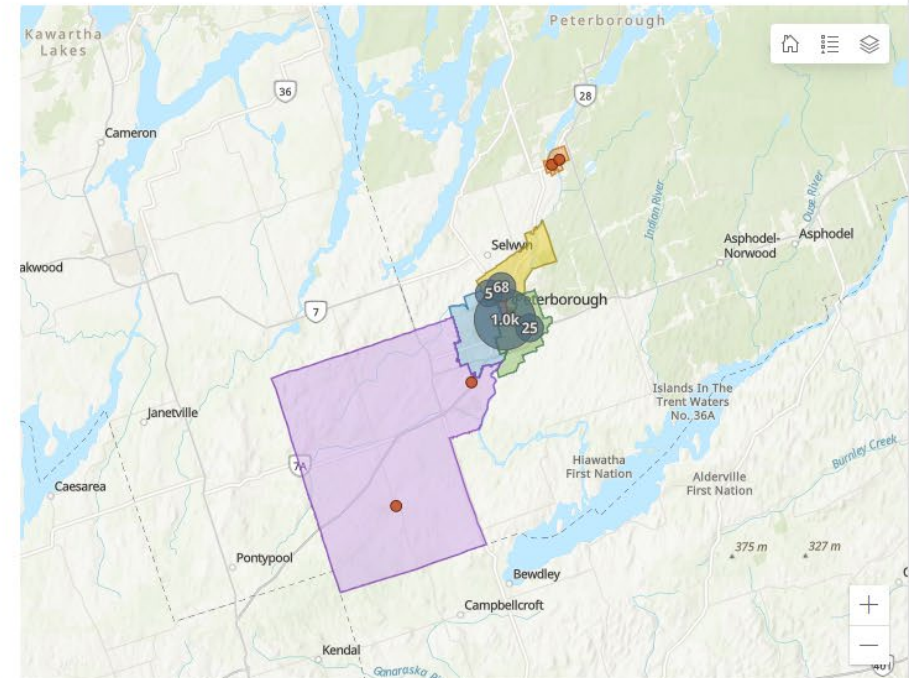

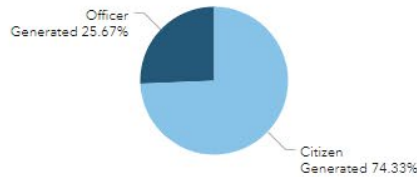

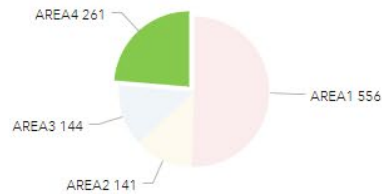

Count of Calls by Area



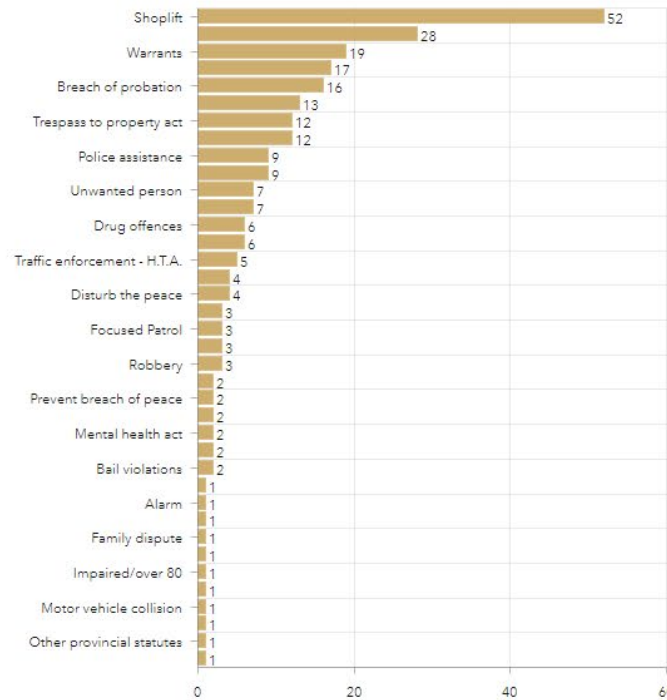

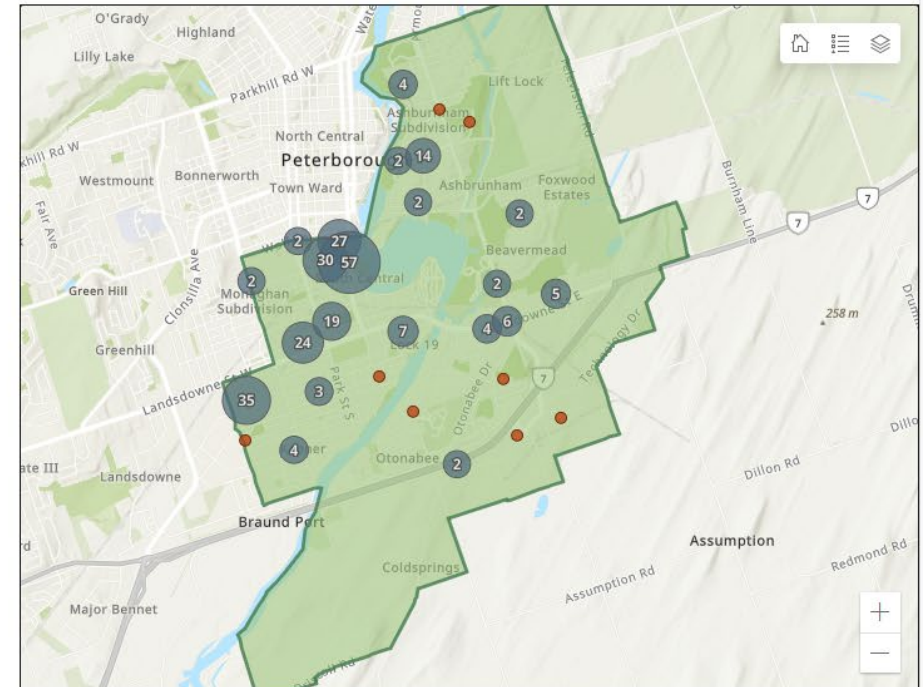

The Safer Public Spaces approach is about balancing the needs and expectations of all residents in our community.

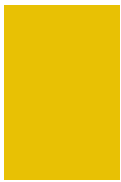
The Service understands and recognizes the need for a compassionate response for those suffering with addictions and expects officers to be kind in their engagements with individuals.

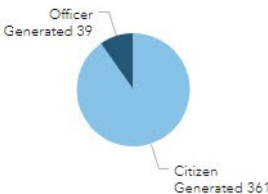
Total Count of Calls by Area

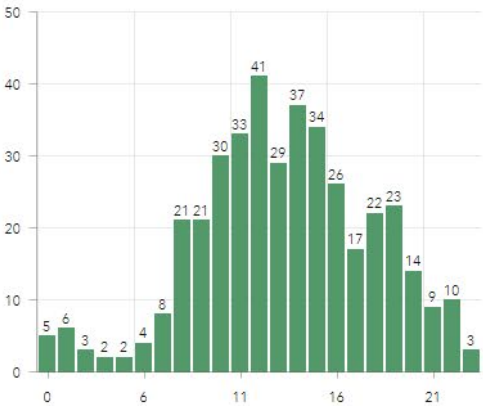
Total Count of Calls by Generated Type



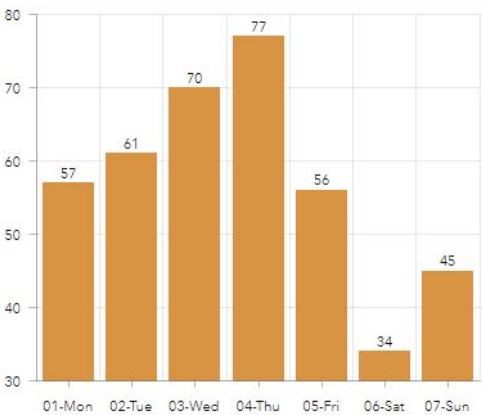

Count of Calls by Time of Day (Hour)

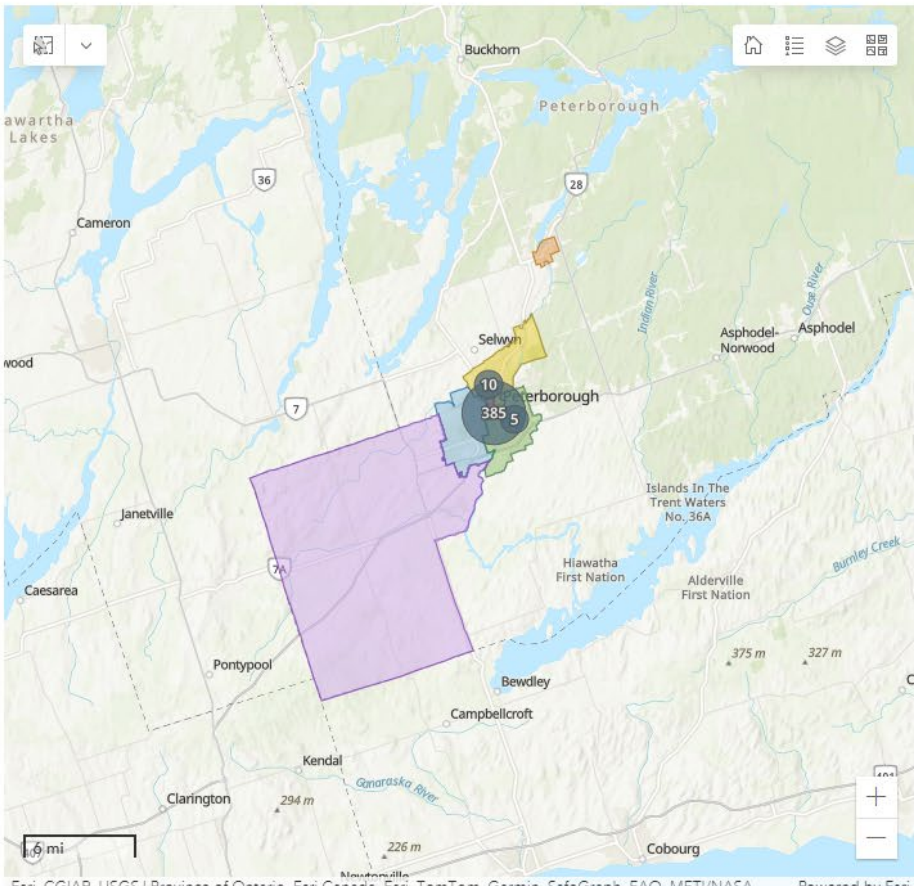


Count of Calls by Weekday



Safer Public Spaces Call for Service Locations

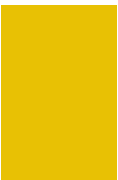

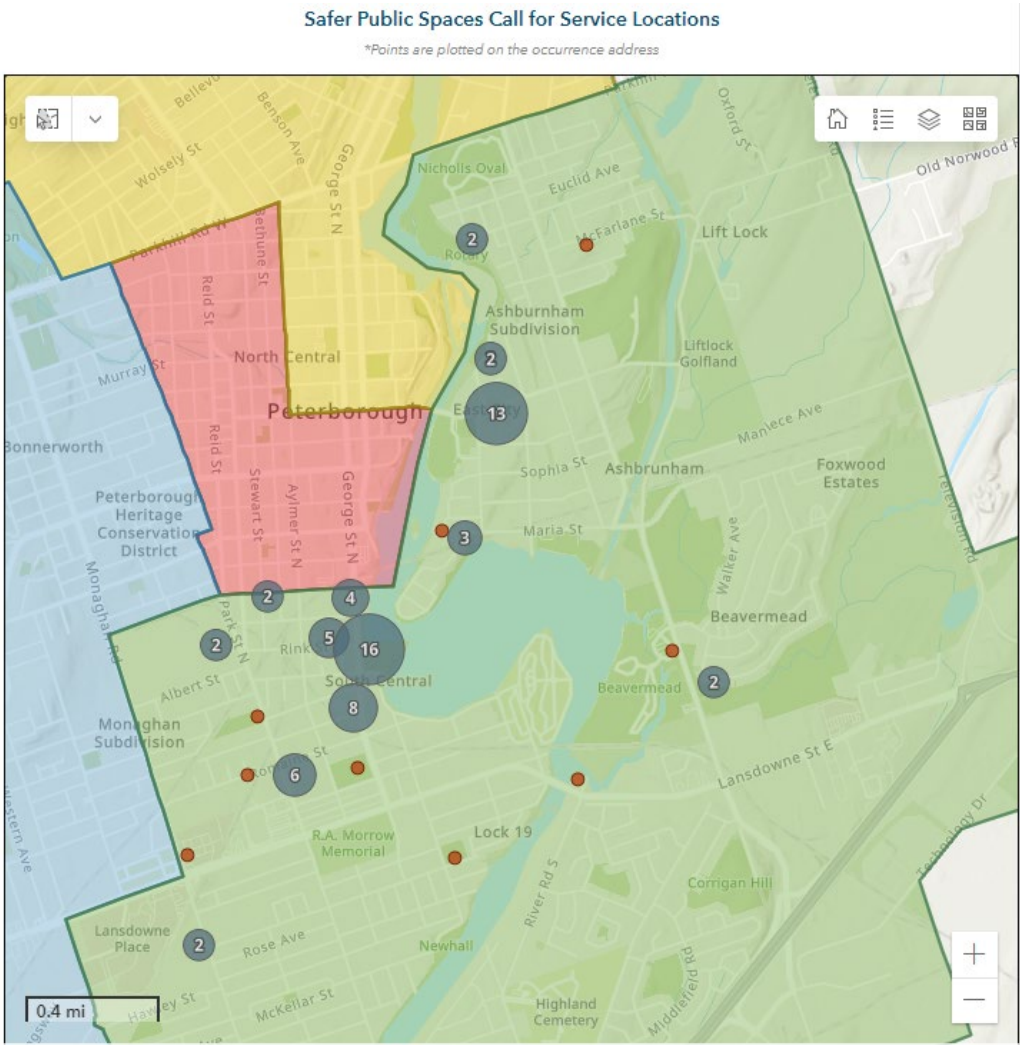
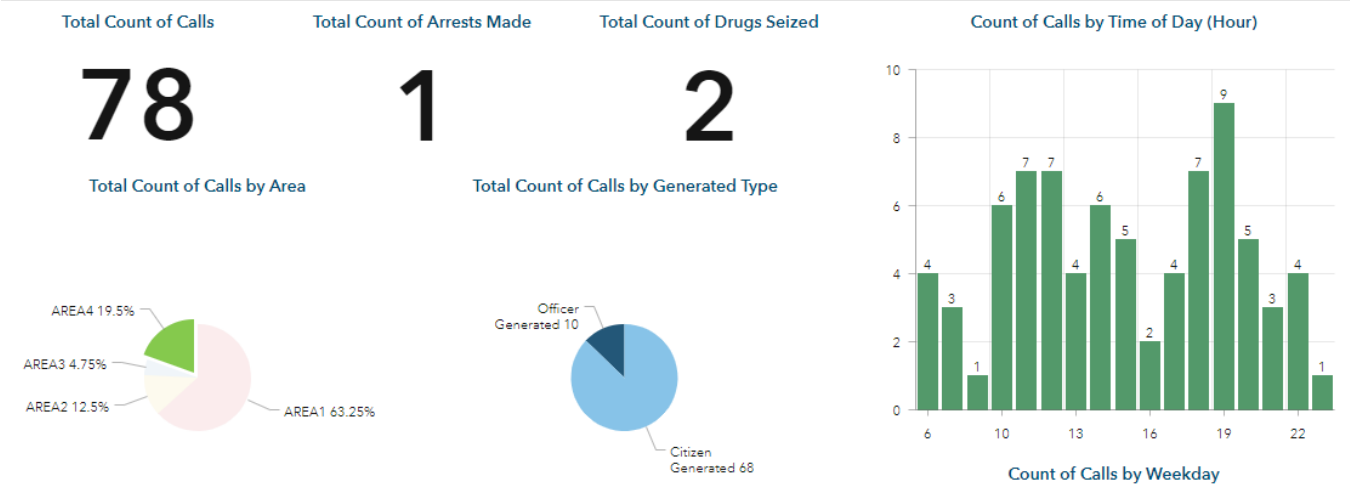
