Monaghan Ward is in Area 3.



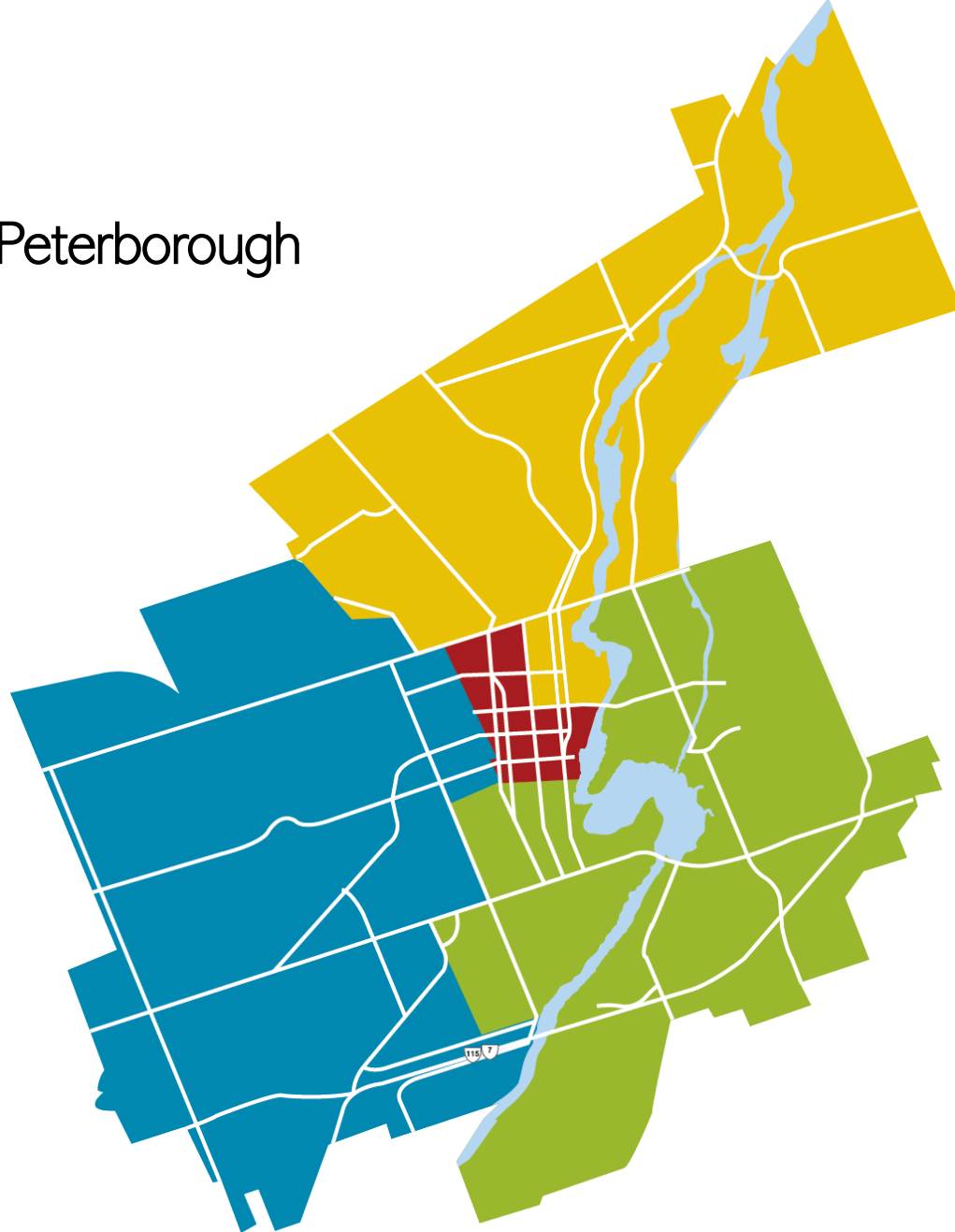

Crime Severity Index (CSI)

Overall CSI (Violent & Non-Violent)

Peterborough is **21st** out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Overall CSI  **5.07%** over 2022.

Violent CSI

Peterborough is **15th** out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Violent CSI has  **1%** over 2022.

Non-Violent CSI

Peterborough is **23rd** out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Non-Violent CSI has  **7.37%** over 2022.

Statistics



Peterborough Police Service (All Areas)

30,986 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Sept 30/24) ↑ 12%

5501 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 17.8%

3633 criminal charges have been laid = ↑ 36%

Largest increase in charges were for: Fraudulent Use of Credit Card (↑ 209%)

Fail to Comply with Probation (↑ 63%) & Utter Threats (↑ 57%)

Area 3 – Westend

6241 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Sept 30/24) ↓ 1%

1072 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 17.2%

Area 3 consists of the City's west-end which covers a large area of residential, commercial, and industrial. This area includes Fleming College and Peterborough Regional Health Centre.

When to call 9-1-1

- Call 9-1-1 if it is an emergency and you require police, fire or ambulance for a crime in progress
- Your life or someone else's is in danger (e.g., assault, motor vehicle collision, impaired driver, active fire)
- You or someone else is having a medical episode

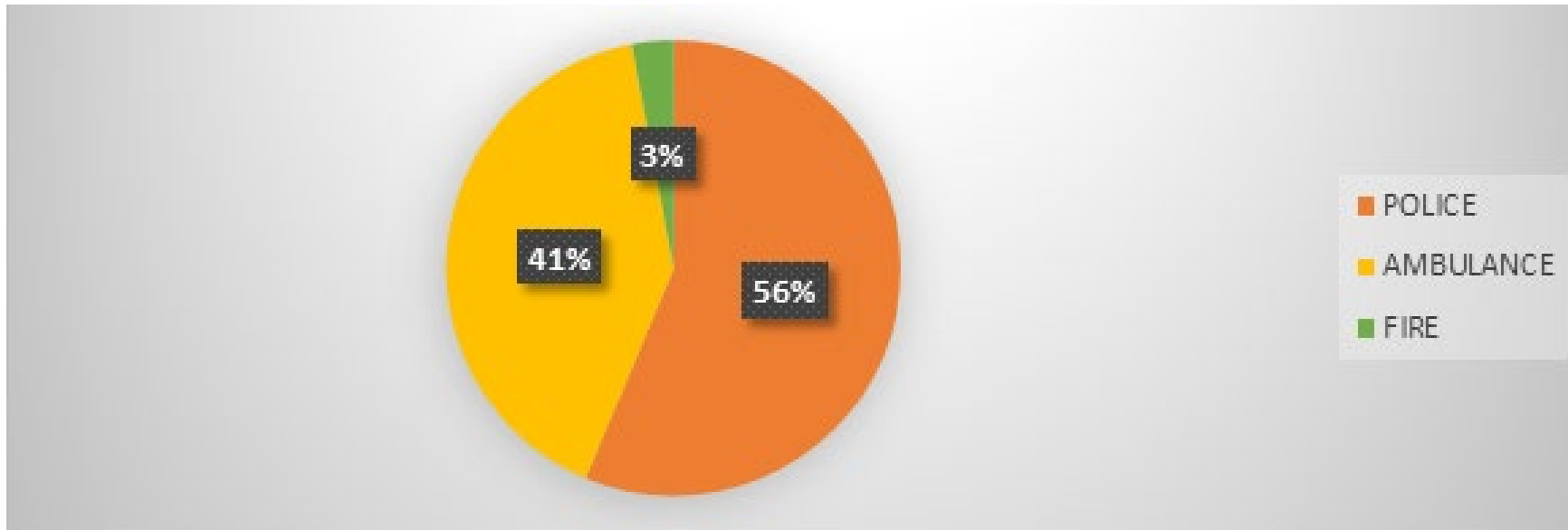
9-1-1 Statistics



From January 1st to August 31st, 2024

- 9-1-1 calls **27,271** have been answered (average of more than **111/day**)
- Hang-up calls – 4,666*

Call **705-876-1122 X225**

To report an incident that is not immediate in nature.

E.g., A property crime you have just discovered but is not in progress

Non-Emergency Call Statistics



- From January 1st to July 31st, 2024, Peterborough Police Service Communicators answered **66,848** non-emergency phone calls. These are separate and apart from 9-1-1 calls.
- (This is an average of more than **313** non-emergency calls per day)
- In the month of July 2024 Peterborough Police Service Communicators answered 10,566 non-emergency calls.

- CAMSafe is a volunteer registry of CCTV, video cameras and doorbell cams in the City of Peterborough, Village of Lakefield, and Township of Cavan-Monaghan.

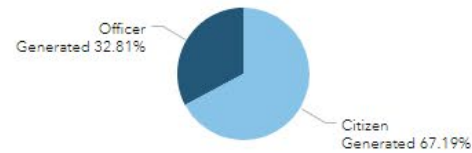

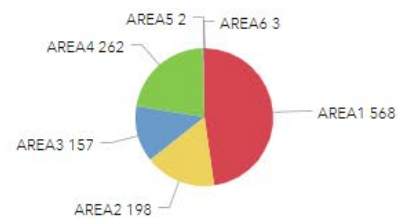

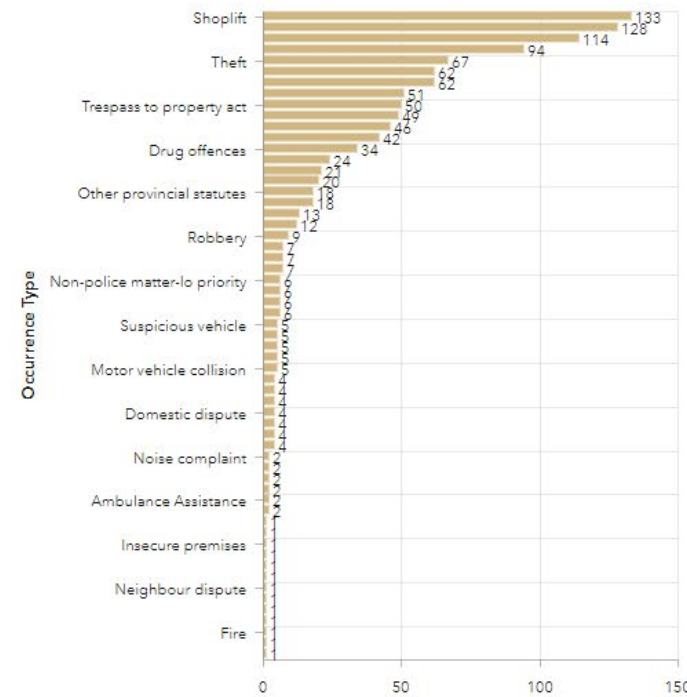

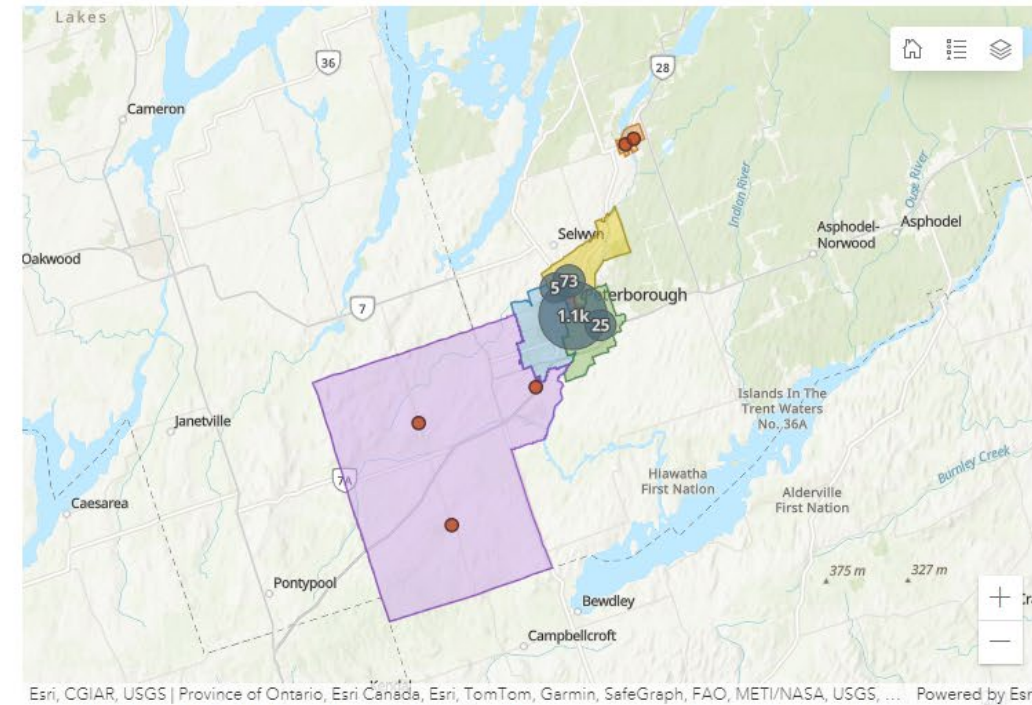

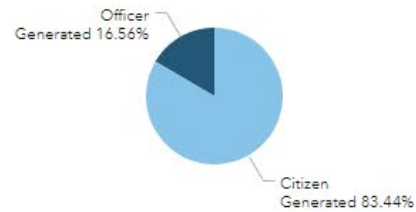

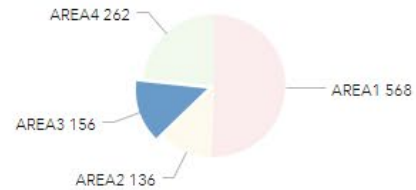

Count of Calls by Area



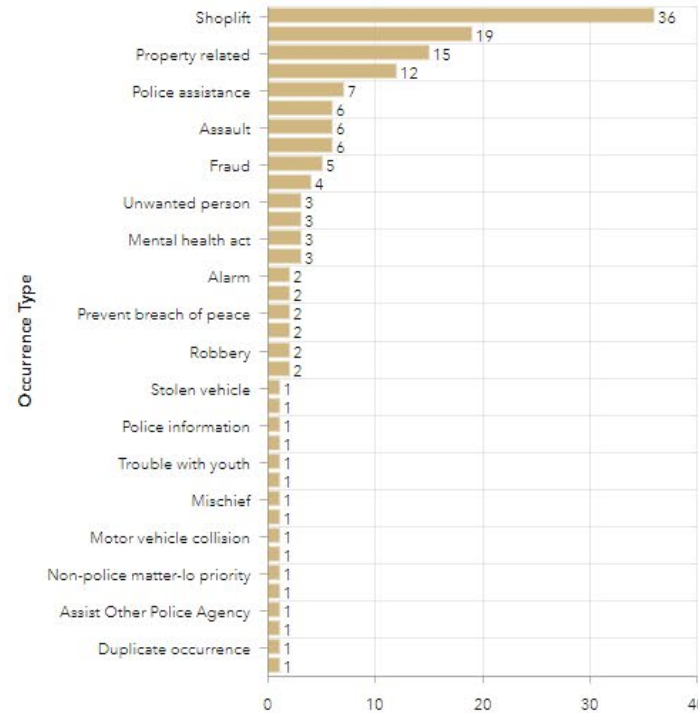

Count of Calls by Occurrence Type

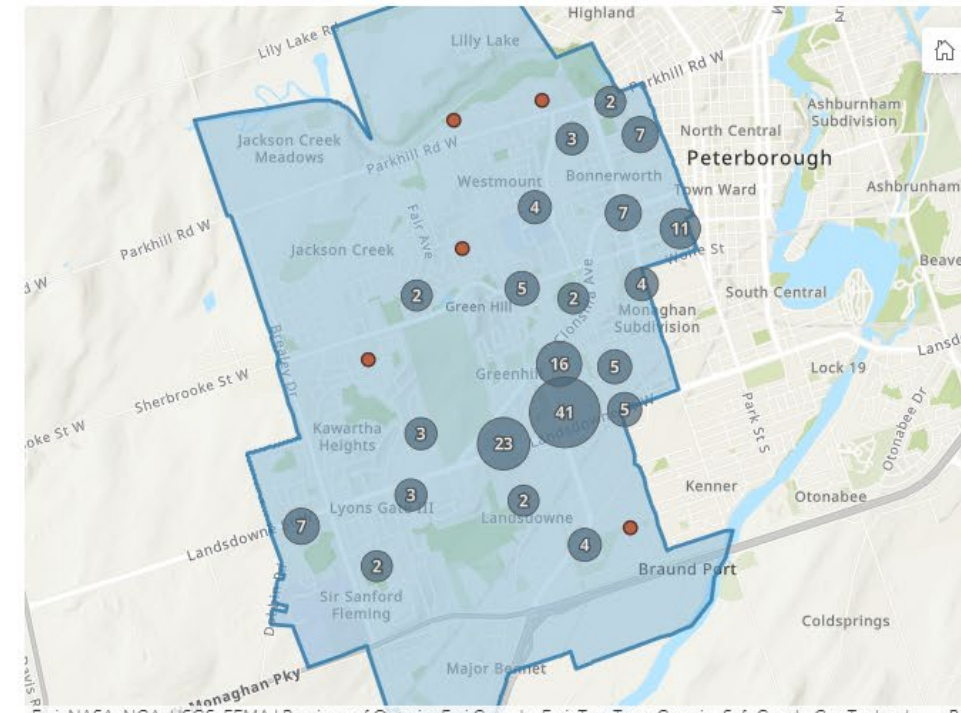

A No-Tolerance Approach to Open Air Illicit Drug Use



- Balancing the needs and expectations of all residents in our community.
- There is a need for a compassionate response for those suffering with addictions and we expect officers to be kind in their engagements with individuals.
- The Service also knows that the community expects that public places such as parks, places of business, and most importantly places where our children go such as playgrounds should also be safe.
- If officers see open air illicit drug use or if/when we receive a call for service from a concerned resident we will attend and direct that person to stop and move to a different location.

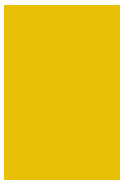

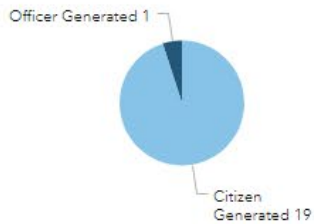
Total Count of Calls by Area

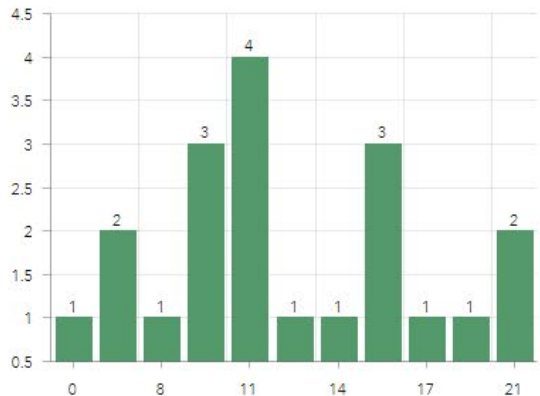
Total Count of Calls by Generated Type



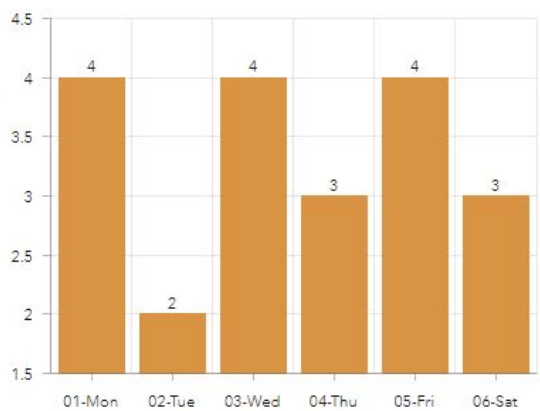
Total Count of Drugs Seized

Count of Calls by Time of Day (Hour)

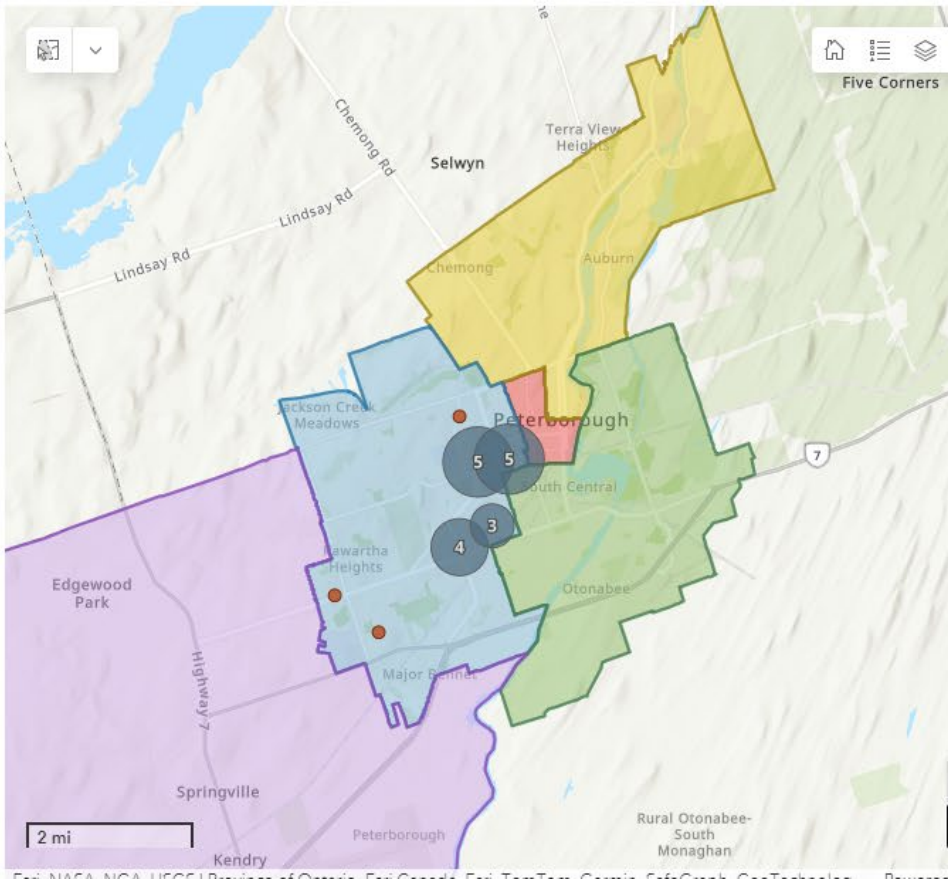


Count of Calls by Weekday
