There are **161** deployable officers and about **90** civilians serving Peterborough, Lakefield and Cavan-Monaghan


There are six policing areas.


Monaghan Ward is in Area 3.

Crime Severity Index (CSI)

Overall CSI (Violent & Non-Violent)

Peterborough is 21^{st} out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Overall CSI \downarrow 5.07% over 2022.

Violent CSI

Peterborough is 15^{th} out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Violent CSI has 15^{th} over 2022.

Non-Violent CSI

Peterborough is 23^{rd} out of the 43 Ontario municipal police services. Non-Violent CSI has $\sqrt[4]{7.37\%}$ over 2022.

Peterborough Police Service (All Areas)

30,986 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Sept 30/24) 12%

5501 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 17.8% 3633 criminal charges have been laid = 17.8%

Largest increase in charges were for: Fraudulent Use of Credit Card (1 209%) Fail to Comply with Probation (163%) & Utter Threats (157%)

Area 3 — Westend

6241 Occurrences (Jan 1 – Sept 30/24) J 1%

1072 of these occurrences were criminal in nature = 17.2%

Area 3 consists of the City's west-end which covers a large area of residential, commercial, and industrial. This area includes Fleming College and Peterborough Regional Health Centre.

When to call 9-1-1



- Call 9-1-1 if it is an emergency and you require police, fire or ambulance for a crime in progress
- Your life or someone else's is in danger (e.g., assault, motor vehicle collision, impaired driver, active fire)
- You or someone else is having a medical episode






9-1-1 Statistics



From January 1st to August 31st, 2024

- 9-1-1 calls 27, 271 have been answered (average of more than 111/day)
- Hang-up calls 4,666*

When to call the general (non-emergency) line



Call 705-876-1122 X225

To report an incident that is not immediate in nature.

E.g., A property crime you have just discovered but is not in progress



Non-Emergency Call Statistics



- From January 1st to July 31st, 2024, Peterborough Police Service Communicators answered 66,848 non-emergency phone calls. These are separate and apart from 9-1-1 calls.
- (This is an average of more than 313 non-emergency calls per day)
- In the month of July 2024 Peterborough Police Service Communicators answered 10,566 non-emergency calls.

They are a resource and can be reached by phone at 705-876-1122 X274








The Peterborough Police Service utilizes Social Media to share information.






Homeguard

 Members of the Auxiliary Unit attend and conduct a home security audit.
They inspect windows, doors, and the exterior of the home. A written report is provided to the homeowner detailing potential improvements, for maximum safety.

• This allows community members to take an active role in making their homes less susceptible to criminal activity.







- Members of the Auxiliary Unit attend and conduct a business security audit. A written report is provided to the business owner detailing potential improvements, for maximum safety.
- This allows local business owners to take an active role in making their businesses less susceptible to criminal activity.



CAMSafe



- CAMSafe is a volunteer registry of CCTV, video cameras and doorbell cams in the City of Peterborough, Village of Lakefield, and Township of Cavan-Monaghan.
- It allows officers to know much like a phonebook – the location of video cameras in and around a community and then who to contact to get any footage.
