LE-018 - Witness Protection

1.0 Policy

- 1.1 It is the policy of the Peterborough Police Services Board with respect to witness protection and security that the Chief of Police will:
- a) establish procedures and processes in respect of witness protection and security; and
 - b) ensure that the police service has a Witness Protection Liaison Officer, or an arrangement with another police service to use their Witness Protection Liaison Officer.

2.0 Administration

- 2.1 That this Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20th day of October 2014 and shall take effect on January 1st 2015.
- 2.2 That this policy be unrestricted.
