Policy on Reimbursement of Expenses and Legal Costs to Former Board Members and Former Board Staff

1.0 Policy Statement

The Peterborough Police Services Board desires to enact a policy to ensure the establishment of procedures that will regulate the reimbursement for expenses and legal costs for former members or former board staff, acting in good faith.

2.0 Application

This policy applies to former members and former board staff of the Peterborough Police Services Board.

3.0 Authority

The Peterborough Police Services Board shall establish policies for the effective management of the police service under *section 31, Police Services Act, 1990*.

3.1. Implementation

- (i) A former member or former board staff of the Peterborough Police Services Board, required to attend a judicial or like proceeding, with respect to their activities while a serving member of the Board shall be entitled to legal services support and to claim expenses in the same manner to which they would be entitled if they were a current member of the Board. Reimbursement shall be upon written request, including

supporting documentation and after final approval by resolution of the Board.

- (ii) If former board members or staff of the Peterborough Lakefield Police Services Board are required to attend a judicial or like proceeding with respect to their previous Board duties, the Board may forward a request to Council for remuneration for their time spent in connection with said proceedings.

4. Administration

- 4.1 This Policy is hereby enacted by the Peterborough Police Services Board on this 20th day of October 2014 and shall take effect on January 1st 2015.
- 4.2 That distribution of the Policy be unrestricted.
